HOW EASY IS THIS!!! For nearly 9 months, Catholic Charities has been promoting the “It’s a Gas to Give” campaign to raise funds for **Elizabeth House** and **Feed the Hungry programs**. The first cheque from Husky came in at \$367 (with only 14 Cards being used), the second cheque was \$753 (with 35 Cards being used) and the third cheque just arrived proving a further \$656 (with 31 Cards being used).

And just last month, 125 parishioners of **St. Thomas More Parish** in Calgary signed up for Husky Community Rebate Cards.

WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO ELIZABETH HOUSE AND FEED THE HUNGRY. \$6 provides a hot, nutritious meal to an impoverished person and every \$1 for Elizabeth House contributes to the shelter, counseling and support of a marginalized young mother and her child.

WHAT IS THE HUSKY COMMUNITY REBATE CARD?

Husky will rebate 2% of its retail sales from Husky and Mohawk locations and Husky House Restaurants to identified charities. The Husky Community Rebate Card is not a credit card and is provided by Catholic Charities for use when making purchases at any of these locations across Canada. Rebate Cards swiped through the Card reader will direct the rebate from purchased to Catholic Charities for Elizabeth House and/or Feed the Hungry.

Catholic Charities does not have a strategic alliance with Husky or Mohawk, but is taking advantage of an opportunity offered by Husky to increase funds needed to operate its programs.

WHAT ABOUT THE ETHANOL BLENDED FUELS?

Husky’s literature states that their mid-grade and premium fuels contain 10% ethanol while their regular fuel does not yet contain ethanol. They also state that vehicles sold in North America are approved for 10% ethanol blended gasoline but that some older vehicles may not be equipped for ethanol. **It is recommended that you consult your operator’s manual to determine if your vehicle is equipped for ethanol fuel.**
